



## **Georgia Institute of Technology Progress and Service Award**

### **What is the Progress and Service Award?**

The Georgia Tech Student Government Progress and Service award was established to recognize students who have made an impact on the Georgia Tech community. The award is for any undergraduate student who has portrayed the ideals of Progress and Service in their Georgia Tech careers. Included in the award is a stipend, awarded to the recipients at the Annual Student Government awards banquet. Three undergraduate students will be given the distinction of this award.

### **Who is eligible for this award?**

Any undergraduate student, in good academic standing will be eligible for the award. The student must not be a member of the Undergraduate House of Representatives or the Student Government Academic Affairs Committee. In order to be considered for this award, the applicant must complete the below application and complete an interview with the SGA Academic Affairs Committee.

### **When is the application due?**

The **application is due** on **April 3, 2008** at **5PM** and may be turned in at the SGA office located in the Student Center commons.

### **When are Interviews?**

Interviews will be conducted during the week of April 6. If you are chosen as a finalist, you will be invited to an interview before the selection panel during that time.

### **When will I be notified about the status of my application?**

Recipients of the award will be announced by **April 14, 2009**. The award will be given at the annual SGA Awards Banquet on April 21, 2009.
