Dr. Jamie Bracey - Director of STEM Education, Outreach and Research | Temple University's College of Engineering | Oberling College, Rochester Institute of Technology and Temple University

Dr. Bracey is an award winning Educational Psychologist and responsible for developing and managing external community relations, policy development, education programming and collaborative research partnerships related to STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) teaching and learning. In 2008, Dr. Bracey co-founded the Urban STEM Strategy Group (PA-NJ-MD) and has hosted public hearings on access to quality education for minority students; convened a historic 2009 Engineering Deans' Symposium for 21 institutions to improve retention of minority students; and authored 2010 legislation for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to create a Math, Engineering and Science Achievement (MESA) initiative serving the state and northeast region of the United States.



Dr. Linda Braddon - President of Secure BioMed Evaluations | SecureBME | BS in Engineering from Mercer University and a Ph.D in Mechanical Engineering from Georgia Institute of Technology

Currently, Dr. Braddon provides consulting services in the areas of risk assessment, mechanical test design and execution, quality systems and product development. Dr. Braddon's professional experience includes extensive work in tissue engineering with a specialty in biomechanics, biofluids and bioprocesses. She is the co-inventor of a U.S. patent for an orthopedic device that is CE marked and is currently going through the FDA approval process. Dr. Braddon has conducted considerable research, and has been published on various tissue and bioengineering topics.
