We announce the first RoboCup industrial forum, RoboCup 2015 Ecosystem Summit, which will be held on July 21. Any participant has a chance of attending the forum by registering as “Attendee” for free. We also announce the sponsorship of Intel (China) for RoboCup 2015. Besides the announcements, the newsletter contains a notice to all participants about the consent forms. All participants are required to sign and submit the forms as usual.

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1. Announcement 1: RoboCup 2015 Ecosystem Summit

We are delighted to announce that RoboCup 2015 Ecosystem Summit, the first industrial forum as a satellite event of RoboCup World Competition and Symposium will be held on July 21. The venue will be the multi-function hall on the second floor of the main venue, Anhui International Conference & Exhibition Center (Fanhua Avenue, Hefei). The organizer of the summit is the LOC of RoboCup 2015. The undertaker is Intel (China).

The summit is a forum about Robotics research and development among academic communities, industries, and governments. Excellent talks by top scientists, enterprisers and government officials will be given at the forum. All the talks will be simultaneously interpreted from English/Chinese into Chinese/English.
