All participants including those who are using other company than NIPPON EXPRESS, except for those who bring their items by hand (e.g. carry-on baggage) without using trucks are required to submit application form to NIPPON EXPRESS Nagoya by email.

Attention for those who are applying for "category i:

Please do not send the original ATA Carnet to Japan side. The original ATA Carnet is required at the departure side.

Power of Attorney (POA) is required if you assign Nippon Express as Customs broker. Please send a photocopy of POA to Nippon Express Japan by Email. The original form of POA should be sent to their oversea branch at the departure side. Given proper instructions to do so, their oversea branch will ship it to Japan along with your cargo. Please take caution that the signature of POA and the Holder of ATA Carnet must be the same.

All shipments except for what is brought by hand must be once gathered in the NIPPON ESPRESS HUB warehouse.

Without an application form, acceptance of goods at the HUB warehouse may be refused and trucks without application may be refused at the site and therefore it may cause delivery failure unless you bring the cargo by hand without using truck.

4. Carry-on Baggage

If you plan to carry your robots or batteries with you, please check with your airline in advance regarding which items you can bring as carry-on baggage. Each airline has its own guidelines and restrictions regarding carry-on baggage.

If you are planning to bring your robots with you as carry-on baggage, you are advised to apply for an ATA Carnet before your departure in order to facilitate the customs clearance. Please contact the ATA Carnet issuing authorities in your country for information such as the costs, processing time, or necessary documents for your application.

5. Travel On-site

Arriving in Nagoya from overseas

Located about 40 km from Nagoya, Central Japan International Airport (Centrair) is conveniently connected to Nagoya and various locations across central Japan by public transportation.

Access to the venue

Nagoya Station is the most convenient arrival point since it offers easy access to the venue.

From Nagoya Station to Kinjo-futo Station (the station nearest the venue), you can take the Aonami Line, which takes approx. 24 min.

From July 27 (Thu) to July 30 (Sun), the special train will be operated by non-stop, takes 17 min. between Nagoya Station and Kinjo-futo Station.
